# Copiah Educational Foundation Driver Education

- 2 parts: Class time and driving time
- Students will not receive a certificate of completion until both parts are completed
- Students cannot complete course without a permit/license
- Fee for class is \$175
- Copiah Educational Foundation offers two sessions for the course. One in November, December and one in June. The class time part will be completed during these months, driving time will be completed as students obtain permits/licenses and are able to drive.

## Students that have a permit or license

- Must have their permit/license with them at all times
- \$175 for driver education class fee

## Students that do not have a permit or license

Requirements to obtain a permit or license.

- A completed Application with notarized signatures of both parents or guardians. If Parents are divorced, parent with custody must sign. (Application provided by driver education instructor)
- A social security card. Effective August 01, 2014 the Social Security Administration will no longer offer Social Security printouts. (Note: Metal social security cards are not acceptable.)
- A certified Birth Certificate. Must be original long form or a certified copy, have a raised seal and be issued by the Bureau of Vital Statistics or State Board of Health.
- If under 18 years of age, you must show proof that you are in school by presenting a signed Certification Of School Attendance form obtained from the school that you are attending. (Note: This form is not valid if over 30 days old.) Provided by Copiah Educational Foundation.
- Two Proof of Domicile
- 14-year-olds will need a DE-7 form provided by driver education instructors
